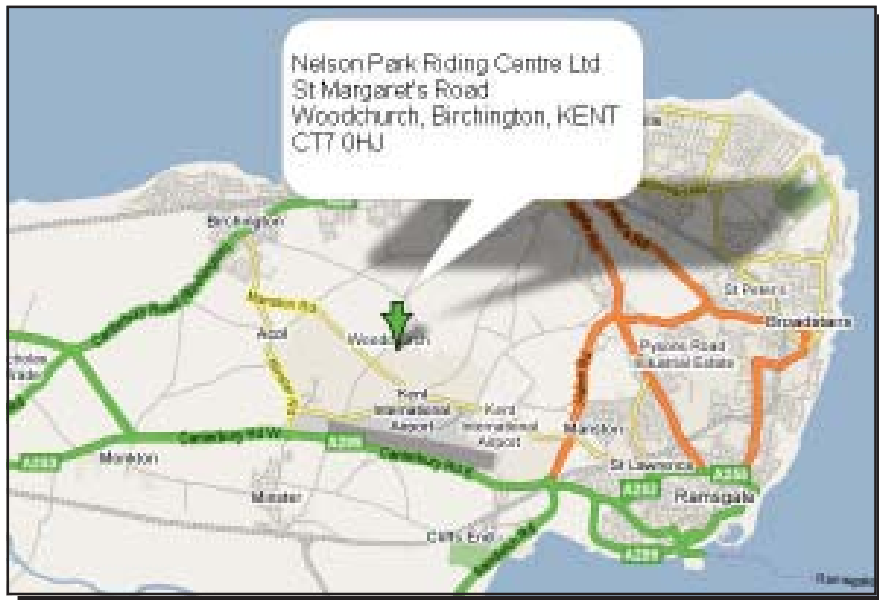


# How to find us !

**From Sandwich / Dover.** Follow A256 in direction of Ramsgate past Pfizer Past Richborough Power Station and petrol station left turn into Ebbsfleet Lane Continue over level crossing. ## RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO SHOWS

NOTE : on signing your entry form you are confirming that you have read and will abide by these conditions of entry.

1. The judges decision is final. Any objection/complaint must be made to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the event. The fee of £15.00 will be refunded if the objection is upheld. Verbal objections will not be accepted.
2. Hats conforming to at least the minimum current British Standard must be worn when mounted, with the chin strap correctly fastened.
3. Whilst every care will be taken, Nelson Park accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or accident to any person or their property, however caused whilst on the showground. Children must be supervised at all times. 
4. Nelson Park reserve the right to refuse entry without stating a reason and to amend or cancel any classess or prizes as they deem fit.
5. All vehicles are parked at their own risk. To ensure smooth flow of traffic, please follow the parking stewards instructions and park where indicated.
6. Any person seen using whips and spurs with undue severity or ill-treating any animal may be asked to leave the showground. Any person abusing, either physically or verbally, any judge, steward or official of the Show will be asked to leave.
7. Riders and owners are responsible for their horse's safety and that of other competitors and spectators
8. No entry fee will be refunded unless a Vet's or Doctors's Certificate is produced.
9. All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years old and over.
10. No DOGS are allowed on the premises.
11. Please do not leave dropping's, hay, straw or shavings on the Car Park please take all your rubbish home.
12. ALL COMPETITORS **MUST** HAVE INSURANCE COVER TO AT LEAST 3RD PARTY.
13. For the protection of your own horse and others he/she may come into contact with, please ensure your horses's flu vaccination is upto date.
14. Please do NOT leave horse / ponies tied to horse boxes / trailers unattended.
15. You are not perimtted to smoke anywhere other than in your own vehicle, all waste material must not be dropped on the yard.

### Passports, Insurance & Disclaimer

All horses/ponies which enter the show ground **MUST** have a valid equine passport and **MUST** be properly vaccinated against equine influenza. Please bring your passport with you to the show as you may be required to show it. **All horses/ponies entering the show ground must have appropriate insurance.**

All competitors and members of the public enter the show ground at their own risk. The show organisers cannot be held responsible for anything that may happen from any cause or circumstances whatsoever to exhibitors, their servants or any person visiting or attending the show. It shall be considered a condition of entry or admission to the show ground that each person shall hold the show organisers harmless and that they shall indemnify the show organisers against any legal proceedings arising from any such case or circumstance. **Rules will be displayed on the day in the secretary's office**

# DISCOUNT SCHEME

Discounts apply to your total spend throughout the year on pony club clinics, pony club weeks, pony days, easter, summer and halloween camps.

Only events that are listed on the payment record qualify for this scheme.

You are responsible for keeping your payment record safe, updated and all payments signed for by a member of staff, Nelson Park will not keep a record of your payments individually.

You will be only issued a voucher for use once you redeem your payment record, so that a voucher can be issued, all vouchers will have an expiry date and can only be used upto that date, they cannot be used for any event or deposit after that date.

#### Combined Training

If entering class 1c or 2c will complete both parts 'a' (jumping) and 'b' (dressage) and be placed in both of these sections alongside the people who ONLY do 'a' or 'b' as well as being placed in the overall combined training section. The dressage score shall be calculated by deducting the percentage from 100 i.e. 60% would equal 40. Jumping faults shall be added to the dressage score to obtain the final combined training score (a pole down = 4; elimination = 50 etc). In the event of a tie, the jump off time will be taken into account.

**Riders can enter the jumping or the dressage elements in any class.**
